Dear McLain Community Families,

This is a reminder that if your child has any signs of illness, please keep her/him home until all symptoms have resolved. Please call your student's absence into your student's learning community attendance line each day with as many details as possible, including all possible COVID-19 symptoms: fever; cough; runny nose; shortness of breath; new or recent loss of taste or smell; sore throat; nausea and/or diarrhea.

If your student has been sent home from the medical safe room, please keep him/her home until all symptoms of illness have resolved. If your child has a history of known allergies, please submit a medical provider note to your district RN stating the baseline allergy symptoms are for your child. This will help the school RN to distinguish your child's allergy symptoms with possible COVID-19 symptoms. Seasonal Allergy Letter

RTD/Light Rail

McLain now has the September bus passes available. The cost is \$34.20/\$17.10-F&R for a monthly pass. You may call the finance office at 303-982-1881 to purchase your passes with a credit card.

Attendance Requirements

As a condition of continued enrollment, McLain students shall maintain "regular school attendance," which means five or fewer unexcused absences per quarter (9-week period). Consistent with District policy, absences from McLain shall be unexcused unless they fall within one of the excused-absence exceptions set forth in <u>District Policy JH</u> and McLain receives suitable proof that the absence is excused, including, but not limited to, a doctor's note or court order.

A student's placement in **Second Chance** (consequence for more than 5 absences) will occur at the conclusion of the quarter for the next quarter. If students are placed into Second Chance, they will be taken out of a core class 3rd period and receive support for their other classes, which will decrease their credit earning potential but hopefully increase their success.

Students are expected to attend all classes on the designated time, for instance, Monday-Thursday, students should be in their 1st period class every day at 8:30 a.m. or students will be marked absent.
