In light of yesterday's school closures, I wanted to reach out and acknowledge how difficult situations like these can be. As parents and as staff we can agree that student safety is, and always will be, our primary concern. When information is limited and/or when dealing with challenging topics, it can be difficult to know what to say to our children.

I think it is important to listen to our kids and have honest conversations with them; yet information should be filtered in order to be developmentally appropriate. While the world can indeed be a scary place, it is important to let kids know that the community acts to keep them safe. The goal of the district and state in this decision is to be smart and err on the side of caution. It's ok to say you don't know the answer to certain questions, while reassuring them that many people are working to keep them safe. Simultaneously, it is important to balance concern with acknowledgment of the all the good in the world too.

Summer School Opportunity at McLain HS

Where: McLain High School, *3rd Floor - Commons*, 13600 W. 2nd Pl., Lakewood, CO 80228

MANDATORY: All students **MUST** attend the first day on Thursday, May 30th. Students must be in the Commons (3rd floor) BY 9:00 am. Students who do not attend this orientation will lose the opportunity to return in the fall (if attending for attendance leave), or their money and the opportunity to recover credit (if attending for summer school).

Dates: Thursday, May 30th - All students must attend.

Monday, June 3rd - Thursday, June 6th - All AL students must attend, optional for summer school students to attend.

Monday, June 10th - Wednesday, June 12th - All AL students must attend, optional for summer school students to attend.

For a total of 8 days. No school on Fridays. Cumulative Exams must be taken at school during one of the before mentioned dates.

Time: 9:00 am - 11:30 am

Cost for Summer School Students ONLY: \$50 for .25 credits, but may take an additional class for free, for a total of .5 credits

Details

Registration:

1. Students must meet with their counselor prior to registration to choose correct summer school class(es).
2. For students who will be placed in attendance leave, conversations about attendance leave during the summer will occur during 4th quarter with Administrator/Dean, and then counselor.

All Students:

1. Must attend mandatory first session on Thursday, May 30th, from 9:00am - 11:30 am.

2. Students can earn up to .5 credits by completing two .25 Edgenuity classes by Wednesday, June 12th, at 11:30 am. Courses not completed by this time will be deleted by the District. Students who wish to earn credit MUST complete the class by June 12th.
3. Students will only be assigned credit recovery courses for credit.
4. Students will be required to complete the comprehensive finals at one of the summer school sessions.
5. Students will complete courses via Edgenuity and can complete coursework outside of the regular summer school hours as Edgenuity is a web-based program.
