Dear McLain Community Families,

As you know, Jeffco Schools has announced a plan to continue instruction during school closures because of the recent COVID-19 outbreak. I wanted to provide some clarity for us as a school for next week.

- Students will be out of school from Monday, March 16 through Friday, March 20. The school district will communicate with families if the closure is extended beyond the break.
- If students do not have computers at home, they will be given one at school today before they leave; Students can also come to the school on Monday, March 16 and pick up a lap top for home use.

The McLain and Long View Remote Learning Plan

- While at home, students will be expected to login to Schoology or Google Classroom for their assigned classes. The McLain and Long View Remote Learning Plan for next week will work as follows:

Tuesday: Period 1 (2 for Long View) – One lesson per day

Wednesday: Period 2 and Extensions (3rd for Long View) – One lesson per day

Thursday: Period 3 (4th for Long View) – One lesson per day

Teachers will use on-line learning tools such as Schoology or Google Classroom to deliver the assignment for students. There is general information on the school's front page on our web page. Student resources will be provided, and technical support can be found on the front page as well. If families need access to WIFI, see the McLain front page for a link to free WIFI. We know that this new model of delivery for school-work is experimental and there may be some technical adjustments required. We will work with students and families to make the process work.
